

ABOUT

Attack808 is a collection of 808-esque sounds from the lovely RackAttack drum synthesizer from german Waldorf. In this library there are 24 sounds inspired by the Roland TR-808, ranging from kicks and snares to cowbell and bass sounds(!).

After recording the RackAttack with a RME Babyface and a Macbook, all sounds were sampled with the legendary Akai S950 sampler in three different settings.

The first setting is as the S950 is when you switch it on. The second setting used a lower sampling rate, and the last setting used an even lower sample frequency and with a signal level way too hot, resulting in a crunchy, noisy sound with attitude.



HOW TO USE

This library is divided into two sections. One with just the wav files (available in both 16 and 24 bits), and one with ready-made kits for our favourite drum sampler Geist from Expansion. The sounds are divided into four categories:

Clean Waldorf

The clean 808 kit from the RackAttack.

Normal Akai S950

The default setting on the Akai S950 (25 kHz).

Dirty Akai S950

Even lower frequency (18 kHz) giving a dirtier sound.

Hot & Lofi Akai S950

Using an even lower frequency (14 kHz) recorded too hot.
