

how to install

This is how you install sounds into Omnisphere 2.

1. Open Omnisphere.
2. Click on the **Utility** button at the top left.
3. Select **Install .omnisphere**
4. Locate the **Plughugger Modus Operandi.omnisphere** file.
5. That's it!

about the sounds

Modus Operandi is the second release in our R&D series. When we start to make one of our proper soundsets for Omnisphere, we always start off with a week or two experimenting with sounds, effects, filter and envelopes. Previously, those sounds were thrown away once we started to work on the real soundset.

The R&D series is where we keep those sounds, polish them up and release them for free as **an exclusive to all our subscribers to our newsletter.**

Modus Operandi is based on the absolutely fantastic OP-1 synthesizer from Teenage Engineering, and these experiments later turned out to become the Operator One soundset for Omnisphere.

None of the sounds in this collection can be found in Operator One. They are all exclusive for this collection.

Modus Operandi contains 35 new presets and 13 new soundsources:

- 6 Arpeggios / Sequences
- 7 Pads / Synth strings
- 5 Bass sounds
- 14 Synth sounds
- 3 Textures and soundscapes
